### Our Common Values...

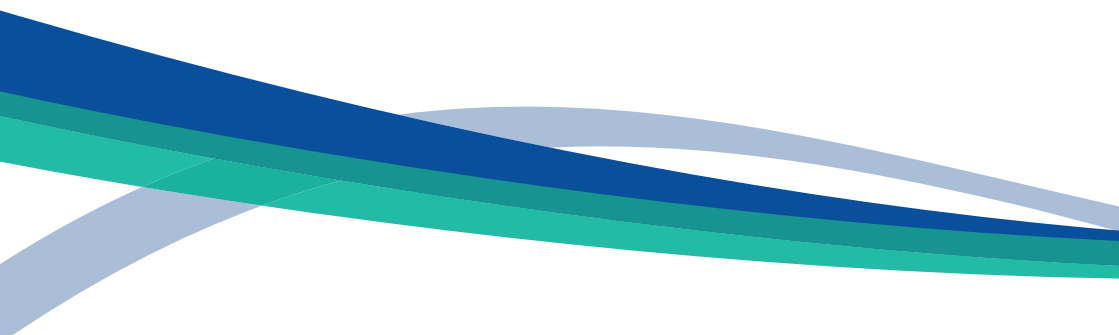
Starting at the point of service delivery, we listen and learn from customers. We use this learning to improve how we work and achieve excellence

## Membership Criteria

Anyone over the age of 16 years can apply to become a member.

We are looking for members who have, in a personal or professional capacity, the knowledge, skills and experience, or an interest in housing and the care of people with housing needs, appropriate to achieving the Association's objectives.

We seek to achieve equality of opportunity. As a result, membership is open to all sections of the community regardless of colour, race, religion, nationality, ethnic origin, gender, disability, age or sexuality. We welcome applications for membership from those who have, in a personal or professional capacity experience of or a personal interest in:

- a) Housing, social work or health;
- b) Finance, Law, business or commerce
- c) Voluntary organisations or academic institutions

Membership is open to nominees of unincorporated bodies, societies and companies. A corporate body may appoint a deputy to exercise its rights and powers at any general meeting of the Association.
